

# Disclaimer

When we say:

**You can learn Esperanto four times faster than other languages**

it does not necessarily apply to all intelligent beings across all spacetime and all possible hyperverses:

<b>You</b>	Means a typical American who speaks only English.
<b>can learn</b>	Does not apply to children, who can pick up multiple languages simultaneously; to people who already speak six other languages; or to geniuses who can learn Cantonese in a week. “Learn” meaning “read, write, understand, speak” to an equivalent level in another language.
<b>Esperanto</b>	With an equivalent amount of study. So, for example, one month of studying Esperanto can get you as far as four months of studying French.
<b>four times faster</b>	<i>Around</i> four times faster, not 4.0000 times faster. Maybe three times, maybe six times. It depends.
<b>than other languages.</b>	We mean, “Faster than you can learn French, Russian, or non-Indo-european languages.” Does <i>not</i> mean, “Faster than you can learn British, Canadian, or Australian.”
