Dear Friends:

We invite you to have a table(s) at the Czech and Slovak Festival on Sunday, October 25, 2009, from 12:00 to 6:00 p.m. at the Baltimore 45 Association, Inc. Hall (formerly Tall Cedars Hall), 2501 Putty Hill Avenue, Baltimore, MD 21234.

For vendors who have items to sell for personal or company profit, the cost is **\$40.00** per table. Tables are approximately two feet by eight feet. You will need to provide your own cover and “skirt.” The hall forbids taping anything to the walls. The rear door will be open for setup at 10:00 a.m., two hours before the festival. Plan to keep your exhibit set up for the full noon-6:00 p.m. scheduled for the festival. We will allow free admission for two persons per table. Others will need to purchase tickets. If possible, please emphasize items relating to Czech or Slovak culture. There is ample parking around the building.

To have a vendor table(s): If you plan to participate and sell items for profit, please send the completed commitment form and your check for \$40.00 per table—**payable to CSHA—by August 31** to Lois Hybl, Chair, Exhibits and Vendors, CSHA, P.O. Box 20261, Baltimore, MD 21284-0261. This will help ensure that you are on the list of exhibitors and vendors in our program book.

Directions to Czech and Slovak Festival: These directions are from Interstate 95 and I-695 (Baltimore Beltway). From I-95, take the I-695 West Beltway exit towards Towson. Merge onto MD-147 S/Harford Rd. exit 31A toward Parkville. At the traffic light about 4.5 miles south on Harford Road turn right onto Putty Hill Avenue. Follow Putty Hill to the hall, which will be on your left in a strip mall.

If you are coming from the west on the beltway, you may also take exit 30 south (Perring Parkway) to Putty Hill Avenue. Turn left on Putty Hill and continue just across Old Harford Road. The hall would be on your right.
