## BUKI in the Plock area

I. Majer Szlama seems to be a transposition of the name Shlomo Mayer, for whom Sol Lask, Sam Bookey, and Sidney Bookey in England are named. We have seen other records for Shlomo Mayer Buki, who died in Wyszogrod in 1880, and a marriage certificate to Golda Rosen, so this is most likely the same man.
MAJER SZLAMA BUKI, a merchant, born 1808 in Lowicz, a son of Josef \& Marye Nelkin Beer. Majer Szlama died in Wyszogrod 6 Aug 1880.His parents were merchants of the cloth \& spices in Lowicz. Majer in Wyszogrod 7 Jul 1824 married to $\mathrm{Go} \geq \mathrm{da}$ Rozen (or $\mathrm{To} \geq \mathrm{ca} \mathrm{Go} \geq \mathrm{da}$. She was born in Wyszogrod 1808 ,/there are many mistakes and inexactitudies in the dates, in another record she was born 1815/, a daughter of merchants of the stuff Chaskel Jakob \& Ella Wozek. The wittness of this marriage was Chaskel Buki born 1780 in Lowicz, a merchant. He was an uncle of Majer Szlama Buki -a brother of his father.
Majer Szlama \& Go $\geq$ da Rozen had 3 children, born in Wyszogrod:

1) Ella Bajla Buki born 1835, married in Wyszogród 5 Feb 1854 to Eliasz Kersztajn born 1834, a son of Szlama \& Rojzel from Wyszogród.
2) Hana Marya Buki born 1841, married in Wyszogrod 1859 to Chaim Enoch Lichtensztajn he was born 1841, a son of MichaelJakob \& Go $\geq$ da Cyril Rozen.
3) Izrael Buki born 1855 .
II. Not sure how this group is related to us.

ICEK BUKI, a baker, was born in Wyszogród 1818, died in Wyszogrod 13 Jan 1871. He married to Ester $\mathrm{Z} \geq$ otnik (or Goldszmidt.She was born in 1826, died after 1879.Their children/all were born in Wyszogrod/:
1.Abram Chaskel Buki, a joiner, born 1854, married 26 Jun 1872 in Wyszogrod to Ma $\geq$ ka Ryfka Kisinman/born in 1852, died in Wyszogrod 17Jan 1879. Abram \& Ma>ka had 2 sons: Berek who was born 1876, died 12 Aug 1888. The second son - Icek Dawid (in the death record of his mother there is not informations about his age)

Abram Chaskel married, as a widower, a second time, in Wyszogród on 25 Jul
