"Wesley was constantly concerned about the role of experience in Christian theology. He was afraid that his followers would become satisfied with a spiritually stagnant orthodoxy that had none of the vitality and power of a personal relationship with God. In one of his most quoted comments he observed: I am not afraid that the people called Methodists should ever cease to exist, either in Europe or America. But I am afraid, lest they should only exist as a dead sect, having the form of religion without the power." (John Wesley: Holiness of Heart and Life, p. 27)
