On the first of March, we enter a new season, the season of Lent. March 13 - Sing a hymn of praise, like Amen, Alleluia!

March 14 – Forgive anyone who has wronged you

March 15 – Pray for our nation's peace & prosperity

March 16 - Read Mark 1:4-8

March 17 - Lift up the mission & work of UMHEF in prayer

March 18 – Rejoice in God's creation on a nature hike today

March 19 - Read 1 Corinthians 16:14

March 20 - Share your story of Jesus' love with someone

March 21 – Pray for all UM related schools & students

March 22 – Write a note of thanks to a solider or veteran

March 23 - Choose to follow Jesus today!

March 24 – Give to help provide scholarships for UM students

April 13 – Worship at a Maundy Thursday service. Luke 22:1-53

April 14 – Remember the suffering & pain Jesus endured for you. Luke 22:54-23:55

April 15 – Be still and think of Mary & how she felt after Jesus' death. Luke 23:56-24:53

April 16 – Easter...Rejoice! He is risen indeed!
