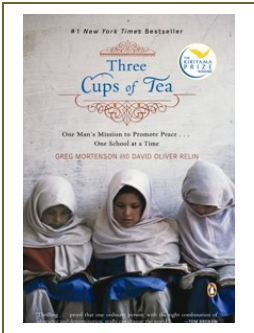
A Note of Appreciation
