

When Jesus saw the crowd around him, he gave orders to cross to the other side of the lake.

19 Then a teacher of the law came to him and said, "Teacher, I will follow you wherever you go."

20 Jesus replied, "Foxes have dens and birds have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head."

21 Another disciple said to him, "Lord, first let me go and bury my father."

22 But Jesus told him, "Follow me, and let the dead bury their own dead." Matthew 8:18-22

The above passage from Matthew is challenging. And it is not about wildlife—nor is it really about the death of a father. It is about letting go of the past letting go of an old identity.

At this time of the year, as the church, we must remember, following Jesus means participation in the resurrection, in the new state of things. Our church, in fact the Church in general, is being reborn, recreated right now. It is up to us, to each one of us, to let go of the old state of things, to let go of the old identity, "let the dead bury the dead" so to speak, so that we may consciously participate in the resurrection. Are we willing to let go?


Holy Week Events next month:
